Am I overloading my washing machine?

When you overload your washing machine, the washer adds extra stress to the motor and the tub bearings and you could damage your appliance.

Sometimes when the washing machine is overloaded, the water does not drain properly and leaks out usually during the spin cycle.



Am I under loading my washing machine?



If you under load your washer, the clothes will accumulate on one side of the drum and bang against the frame when the machine reaches its spin cycle. This is going to throw the washer out of balance and will result in excessive vibrations and vigorous banging noises.

How full should you load a washing machine?

Some washers on the market have larger drums than others, but the majority of washing machines have a capacity between 6 to 10kg.
